She obtained her Masters in Social Science (Clinical Social Work) and PhD in Social Work at the University of Cape Town, South Africa.</p> <p>She was President of the World Federation for Mental Health for the term 2019 – 2021 and currently serves as the Immediate Past President of the World Federation for Mental Health. In her role as President, she collaborated with several global mental health organisations including WHO and launched with her team two successful World Mental Health Day events in 2020 and 2021 during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic. She also serves on the Global Mental Health Action Network’s Communications Steering Committee and has recently been appointed to serve on the Global Alliance for Mental Health Advocates (GAMHA) advisory panel. She served on South Africa’s National Mental Health Advisory Committee who advised the National Minister of Health on the implementation of the National Mental Health Policy Framework and Strategic Plan 2013-2020. She is an Executive Committee and Board member of the South African Federation for Mental Health.</p> <p>Her role has necessitated creating awareness and supported/ reviewed the design of educational materials, doing presentations and writing articles in this regard. She has convened, participated and presented at several Congresses and webinars in South Africa and globally. She teaches at Bochum University of Applied Sciences, Germany on the International Programme on Diversity and Inclusion and Winter Semester programmes. She is currently participating in the project ARISE that is designing a Post Graduate Diploma in Public Mental Health in South Africa. She has an extensive resumé of presentations delivered at national and international levels and has also published several articles.</p>
