Dr. Di Nicola is Co-Founder and Past Chair of the American Psychiatric Association (APA) Caucus on Global Mental Health & Psychiatry and twice elected President of the APA Quebec & Eastern Canada District Branch. Dr. Di Nicola has received numerous fellowships and awards in learned societies, including: Distinguished Fellow of the APA (DFAPA) and the APA Distinguished Service Award; Distinguished International Member of the Bulgarian Association of Sciences & Arts (BASA); Fellow of the Canadian Psychiatric Association (FCPA); and he was elected Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences (FCAHS), Canada's highest honor for scholars in the health sciences.

Dr. Di Nicola's publications include: *A Stranger in the Family: Culture, Families, and Therapy* (W.W. Norton, 1997), *Letters to a Young Therapist* (Atropos, 2011, winner of Quebec's Camille Laurin Prize), and with D. Stoyanov, *Psychiatry in Crisis: At the Crossroads of Social Sciences, the Humanities, and Neuroscience* (Springer, 2021).

As well as his involvement over many years with the Society for the Study of Psychiatry and Culture (SSPC) where he is a current board member and co-founder of the SSPC Family & Culture Interest Group, Dr. Di Nicola is co-founder with Dr. Riyadh Al-Baldawi of WACP's Family & Culture Special Interest Group.
