During her career, she has held multiple roles in undergraduate, postgraduate, and faculty education, including being Course Director for the UEA medical programme during its early years of development and accreditation. She has particular expertise in the teaching and learning of professionalism and patient safety; in the models and effectiveness of involving family medicine in community based medical education; and in resilience and doctors' wellbeing. She has led CPD programmes, is a frequent speaker and contributor at academic and professional conferences, and holds Masters in Medical Education . One of her areas of publication is medical education research, where her CV shows 45 original articles on this theme.</p>
