

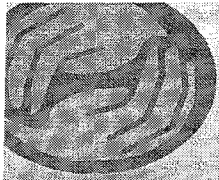

He was its president on the period 2003-2004. - 2004, elected to the Board of Directors of the International Psychogeriatric Association and remained eight years in this position. - Member of the European Psychiatric Association Section of Geriatric Psychiatry in 2004. He was its Vice-Chair until 2010 when he was elected its Chair, a position he held until 2014. Now he is its Councilor. - 2004, Associate Professor at the Institute of Psychiatry at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro, Center of Dementia and other Mental Pathologies in the Elderly of this Institute.
