He is also finalizing his 7<sup>th</sup> book "African Text Book of Psychiatry and Mental Health: Integrated Clinical and Public Health Approaches", which brings together multidisciplinary contributors from Africa and beyond. He is the co-author/editor of the Tasman Text Book of Psychiatry for USA readership.
