He is a graduate of Edinburgh University Medical School, Edinburgh, Scotland. In addition, he holds a PH. D. in Social Research and Welfare from Brandeis University in Waltham, MA, USA. He has been on the faculties of University of Pennsylvania Medical School and Yale University. He was a Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at Vanderbilt University Medical School and a Senior Fellow at the Vanderbilt University Institute for Public Policy Studies. He has also served as Chairman and Professor, Department of Psychiatry at Meharry Medical College in Nashville, TN, USA. He is currently a Clinical Professor of Psychiatry, Department of Psychiatry, George Washington University, Washington, D.C. His research interests have included lithium transport, affective disorders, psychotherapy, and participation in the social benefit programs. Dr. Okpaku has written a number of chapters on the assessment of individuals with a migration background including their expectations and the required treatment skills.</p> <p>He has authored or edited a number of volumes. Among these is <i>Sex, Orgasm and Depression, Their Inter-relationship in a Changing Society</i>, <i>Mental Health in Africa and America Today</i>, <i>Clinical Methods in Transcultural Psychiatry</i>, and <i>Essentials of Global Mental Health</i> which received a high commendation from the British Medical Association. His most recent publication is a two volume edition of <i>Innovations in Global Mental Health</i>.</p> <p>He is an awardee of the World Association of Cultural Psychiatrists for <i>Pioneering Work in Cultural Psychiatry</i> (2018) and also an awardee of the Society for Culture and Psychiatry for <i>Creative Scholarship</i> (2020).
