He is a founding editor or co-editor of two psychiatric journals and editor in chief all four editions of a comprehensive textbook, Psychiatry , called "the best current textbook of psychiatry" by the New England Journal of Medicine and the "gold standard" by the American Journal of Psychiatry. The fifth edition has been renamed Tasman's Psychiatry,5 th Edition by the publisher and will be published in 2023.
